<b>Ravenswood Vintners Blend Zinfandel, California, USA 2007/8</b> Joel Peterson, the winemaker at Ravenswood follows the mantra 'No Wimpy Wines' and this certainly isn't 'Wimpy'. Ravenswood is named after the ravens which Joel insists encouraged him when picking his first harvest of Zinfandel, single handed. 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<b>Valpolicella Classico Bolla 2008/9</b> A tremendous trio of traditional grapes all showing ripe round berry fruits and a liquorice hint.				£22.95
